Song of Songs tells the story of a young woman about to be married to the King. She is not used to royal position and he encourages her to rise up to embrace her new role, to be seen and to speak out.

"It was I who took you and hid you up high in the secret stairway of the sky.

Let me see your radiant face and hear your sweet voice. How beautiful your eyes of worship and lovely your voice in prayer" Song of Songs 2v14
